


CCA Lower ES

Students in 3rd grade warm our hearts with their amazing growth in reading and math. Students are making progress in both areas.


Students in 4th and 5th grade have also made significant growth in math and reading. Most scores exceed the 50% mark!









CCA East


Second grade students at CCA East made significant gains in in math. There is significant growth in grades 2nd, 3rd and 5th grade reading scores.






CCA East Scantron SIP %


6th Grade CCA MS


In 6th grade, there is growth in reading and math. We are expecting a greater increase in the area of reading by the spring.

7th and 8th grade are the heart of our restructuring efforts. In both grades there is minimal growth.






CCA MS Scantron SIP %
