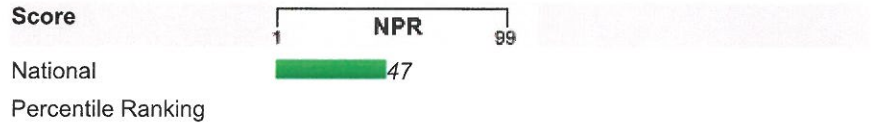
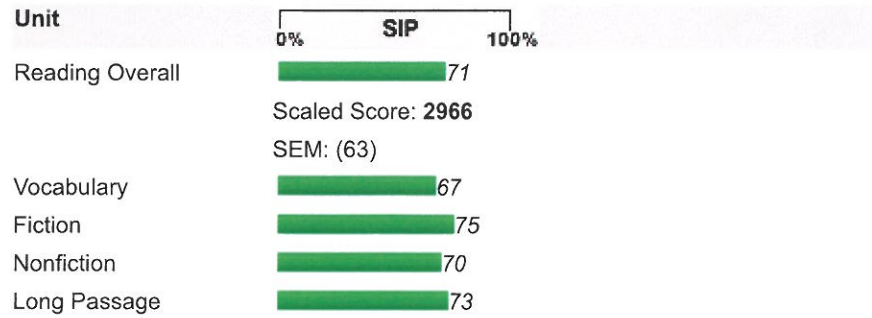

- SIP (%)** Standards Item Pool score. For example, a GLE of 4.5 means that the corresponding Scaled Score is halfway between the average 4th grade score and the average 5th grade score.
